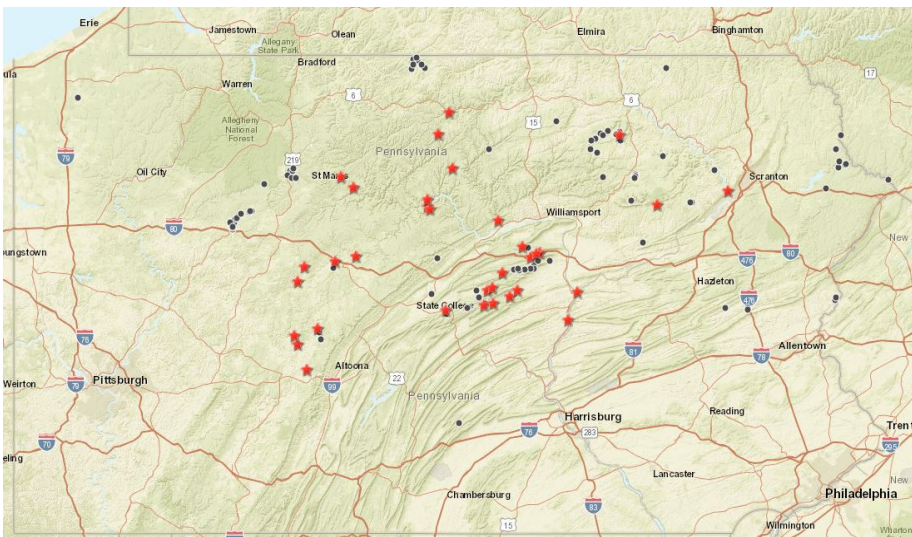

## Tell Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission to approve stream protections

### Make your voice heard for wild trout

On January 22-23, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission will vote to approve protections for new Class A and Wild Trout Streams. Left unprotected, these streams are at risk of pollution, increased sedimentation, reduction in streamside buffers, and higher temperatures—all of which are detrimental to trout populations.

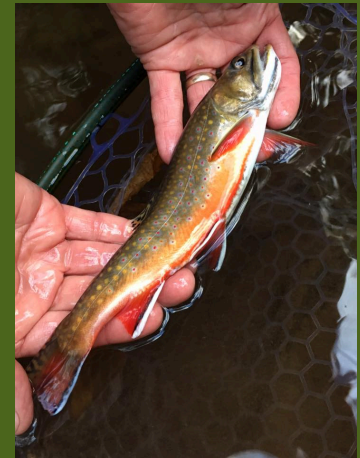
